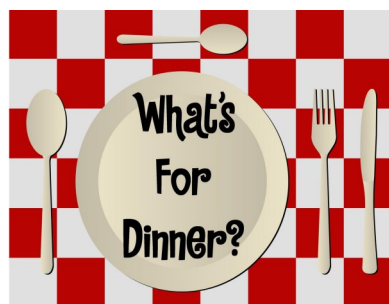

2017 Church Budget Contributions

The 31st of December is only a few days away. There are many things to do during the Christmas holiday season, from working, shopping, cooking, cleaning, and decorating to spending time with friends and family and giving to others. The main focus should always be the celebration of the birth of our Savior, Jesus Christ. Please also take the time to pray for God's guidance on giving your tithes and offerings to the church. Please support the mission of this body of believers, which is "to love God, love people, and make disciples of Jesus Christ."

This year's General Fund budget is \$259,857. Tithe and regular offering contributions to the church through the 19th of December 2018 total \$229,459.16. Donations of \$ 6,417 have been made to the General Fund in memory or honor of individual people. The total of our budget receipts is currently \$235,876.16, which is \$33,980.84 less than budget needs. Please help overcome the shortfall to provide the financial resources needed to execute our church's mission. Contact the church office by December 28 if you want to know what your contributions through December 24 have been.

Reminders From The Financial Management Board

To receive contribution credit for 2017, a donation must either be received by the church before midnight on December 31, 2017, or postmarked on or before December 31, 2017. If the church office is closed, hand-delivered donations may be placed in the exterior mailbox mounted on the porch wall to the right of the Troupe Street entrance double doors. The mail box will be checked at midnight.

The proposed budget for 2018 was approved at the called church conference on December 10, 2017, with a tally of 41 "Yes" votes and 4 "No" votes.
