Whether you want to expand your welding knowledge or you are starting from scratch, you'll receive a great introduction during the Welding Basics course. You will learn the basics of brazing, soldering, sheet metal forming, material cutting, fitting, and getting to know the critical safety components of how to use hand and power tools (grinders, shears, torches, etc.).

Course Objectives:

At the conclusion of the course, you will have a better understanding of the different types of welding and have the welding skills needed to handle basic welding tasks. You will also become familiar with the process for taking the certified welder's exam.
