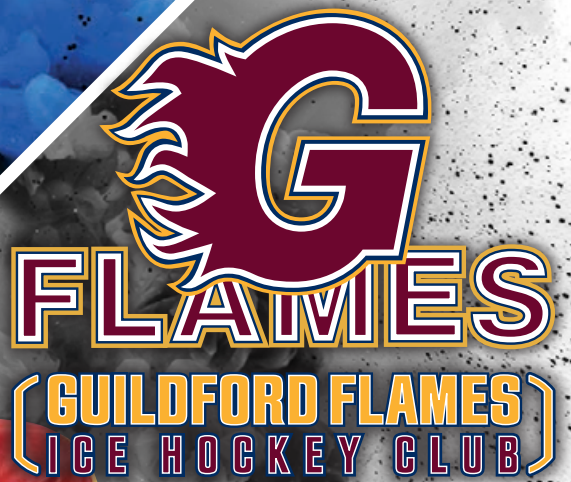


DRUG FREEZE PROGRAMME 2017-2018

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Welcome to the 2017-2018 Drug Freeze Programme sponsored by ISS Facility Services. This is our 24th consecutive season running this successful programme. Our goal is to increase drug awareness amongst young children, whilst promoting a healthy interest in sport & exercise.



The Visit

- ▶ No special facilities are required except for interactive whiteboard (TV and DVD player).
- ▶ Two Flames players will visit the school. Both players are DBS checked and have extensive experience in programme presentation.
- ▶ The visit will start by talking informally about ice hockey. Players will play a short video of game clips and then show their 'kit' to the pupils. This eases the atmosphere before turning to the more serious topic of drug abuse prevention.
- ▶ The visit follows with 40 minutes of Drug Freeze presentation highlighting the social, physical and legal implications of drug use.
- ▶ Before the presentation closes, ticket vouchers for Flames Home matches are provided, each with an anti-drug message, along with player cards, and additional items.
- ▶ The entire presentation takes approximately one hour and is available to a maximum of 60 pupils at one time. If you have more than this attending the presentation, we will be happy to arrange for consecutive visits.

Objectives

- ▶ To give pupils all the information they need to make informed decisions about drugs.
- ▶ To make pupils aware of legal and social consequences of drug misuse.
- ▶ To encourage pupils to achieve their maximum potential at school and in their chosen sport or hobby by showing them positive role models.
- ▶ To advise pupils to talk to trusted adults about drug problems.
- ▶ Introduce the phrase "NOGOTELL" to educate children to say no to drugs and to go and inform a responsible adult of their encounter.

- ▶ The target group is primarily year 5 and year 6.
- ▶ It is recommended that this be used as an introduction to other Drug Prevention and Education Programmes.
